
(Lucas Granach

- Again she was a gracious host




(Jan Sanders van Hemessen)

Lucretia




(Felice Ficherilli)

- Lucretia called her husband and father
- She told them of Tarquinius' black deed
- Instead of having her honor as woman and wife ruined, she committed suicide
- Her death fell on the house of Tarquinius

- Lucretia is a symbol to women
- She displayed courage when she plunged the knife into her heart
- She refused to be shamed
- She brought blame to the man who raped her through death
