Governments maintain order through a variety of administrative institutions, policies, and procedures, and governments obtain, retain, and exercise power in different ways and for different purposes.</p> <p>Theme 4: Economic Systems: as societies develop, they affect and are affected by the ways that they produce, exchange, and consume goods and services</p> <p>Theme 5: Social Interactions and Organization: gender roles and relations; family and kinship; racial and ethnic constructions; social and economic classes</p> <p>Theme 6: Technology and Innovation: Human adaptation and innovation have resulted in increased efficiency, comfort, and security, and technological advances have shaped human development and interactions with both intended and unintended consequences.</p>
